

IFCN Global Outreach (GO) Training Programme

The International Federation of Clinical Neurophysiology (IFCN) Education Committee is pleased to announce the launch of their global outreach training programme for nerve conduction and electromyography studies (NCS/EMG) in limited resource settings. This is a pilot program that will enroll a maximum of 40 participants only.

The target participants are trainees in limited resource settings who do not have access to local training programmes or local neurophysiology/neuromuscular training. The programme serves as a guide to gauge the evolution of their own knowledge and skill in the core skills of NCS/EMG. It is not a measure of competency.

Depending on local training opportunities, it is anticipated that the training period will be completed over a period of one to two years, following which a certificate of completion will be awarded.

What IFCN provides:

1. Remote mentorship will be provided.
2. Access to online learning portal with standardised curriculum on the anatomy, physiology and technical basis of NCS/EMG

What you are expected to do during the programme:

1. Attend sessions of NCS/EMG at regular intervals in your home setting
2. Perform, interpret and report at least 100 “hands-on” NCS/EMG (50 with local supervision) and complete a logbook of genuine cases and reports
3. Attend one of IFCN’s workshop in the Fundamentals of NCS/EMG. For assistance identifying a workshop, you are requested to contact your assigned mentor.
4. Complete assigned online evaluations on the online learning portal.
5. Complete an attachment of a minimum of 3 months at an NCS/EMG training center with local supervision. For assistance in identifying, you are requested to contact your assigned mentor.

Eligibility criteria:

1. Member of the International Clinical Neurophysiology Society (ICNS). If you are not a current member, please complete the ICNS Application [ICNS Application Form](#)



2. Applicants with a minimum of 2 years in core medical training or practice in neurology or rehabilitation medicine are preferred.

3. Have access to NCS/EMG equipment in your local setting.

The IFCN Education Global Outreach Committee will make the selection of successful candidates. Applicants will be informed of the decision by [enter date]
