



Dear Colleagues:

On behalf of the International Federation of Clinical Neurophysiology Executive Committee, (IFCN ExCo), I write with important news. After much deliberation, the committee has elected to move to a new management company to serve the IFCN.

While a change of this scale entails a significant commitment of time, attention and resources, the ExCo believes it is essential in order to advance the strategic goals of IFCN. To that end, we have moved to the services of Executive Director, Inc. (EDI) for our management.

EDI was founded in 1962, and currently has a staff of over 250 professionals serving 40 national and global societies with a focus on medical, health and scientific associations including the American Clinical Neurophysiology Society (ACNS). EDI served as the secretariat for the 2018 ICCN in Washington, DC. It came highly recommended by volunteer leaders of the associations it manages and has an impressive record of success assisting its clients in achieving their strategic goals.

While the transition has begun behind the scenes, the official transition date will be 31 December 2022. For the moment our point of contact is Kay Whalen, MBA, CAE, president of EDI, though she will appoint our new Executive Director soon.

This decision was not made lightly and the process systematic and careful. It required great commitment from our search committee. I want to acknowledge and thank Professors Paulus, Verdugo, Husain and Hallett, for their time and dedication in bringing this to a successful conclusion.

I also want to thank Carol Freysinger, Debbie O'Keefe, Catherine Lamoureux, and the entire administrative staff at Association Innovation and Management (AIM) for their service over the past three years and their commitment to a smooth transition. Their combined efforts are greatly appreciated.
